2018 Carneros Chardonnay

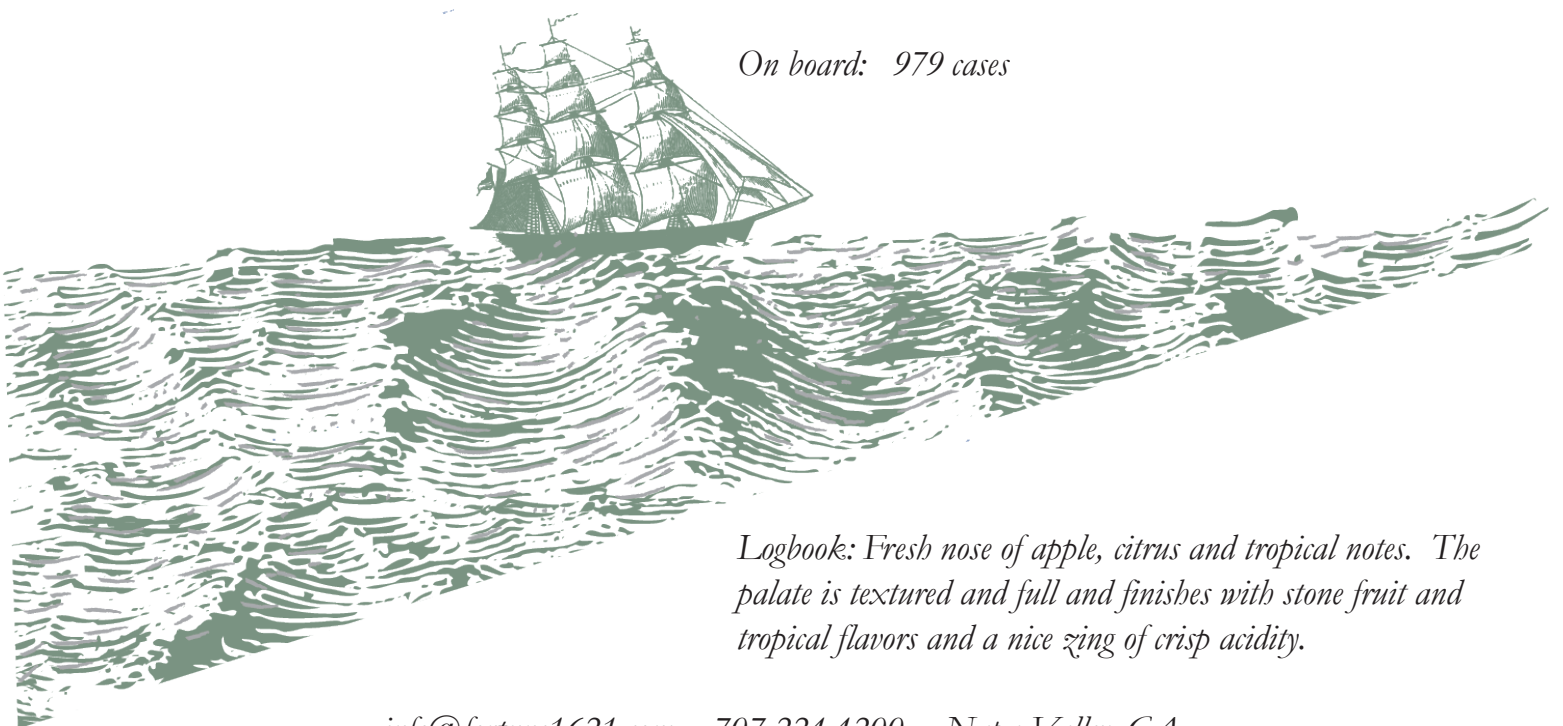
Varietal: Chardonnay
